_____ As a boat owner, I understand that mussels and other invasive species can travel on and in boats.

_____ I know that mussels and other invasive species can harm wildlife, and ruin docks, ramps, boats and motors, water pumps and intakes.

_____ Wet boats and trailers can transport microscopic larvae of invasive species.

_____ As a homeowner, I want to do my part to keep the lakes invasive species-free.

_____ I understand that cleaning, draining, and drying my boat between launches is the best safeguard against transporting mussels and other invasive species and I have followed the protocol below.

*(According to AZ Game and Fish Department, decontamination protocol includes cleaning and removing any clinging material from the vessel, removing the plug and draining water from the bilge, live-well and other water holding compartments when at the previous body of water, and allowing the boat and trailer to dry completely before transport. **Arizona Game and Fish Department recommends that the boat not be re-launched before 5 days of drying have passed.** If you are planning to launch before 5 days, pouring in 1 gallon of vinegar and draining it out of the bilge prior to launching should disinfect the bilge. The external boat and trailer can be disinfected through the use of a hot water cleaning at a car wash).*
